Bankruptcy Clinics take place on the second Friday of each month from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. Three clients are scheduled in that time frame at 10:00, 10:40, and 11:20. The meeting with the client can take place at Legal Action's office or by telephone.

The volunteer attorney interviews the client to evaluate the merits of their case; provides advice tailored to the client's situation; and if necessary, provides brief services such as drafting a letter for credit harassment issues. Volunteers from the UW Madison Law School may be available to assist with inperson meetings.

Clients of Legal Action are low income (at or below 200% FPL) and get signed up for the clinic by calling our office. Before the clinic, we ask them to get a credit report, if possible (if they don't already have one) and we forward that and other information to the volunteer attorney a few days before the clinic. After the clinic, the VLP Coordinator follows up with the clients. If filing for bankruptcy is recommended the VLP Coordinator can try to find a volunteer attorney to assist them.
